

Andrea C. Cameron Memorial Scholarship

Why Should You Apply?:

This is a scholarship built on creating a network. Through this scholarship if you are chosen you will become a part of the family. The foundation will do everything in its power to make sure you are set up for success. You will be mentored but you will also become a mentor for the next recipients following behind you. It is our goal to build a massive networking platform that you will be able to use whilst a student and as a working professional. Eligibility:

- The Andrea C. Cameron Foundation scholarship is open to Jupiter Community High School seniors pursuing technical school or college education.
- Scholarships are awarded to students who have met our academic and social requirements.
- Up to 2 academic scholarships are given out each year in two application cycles.
- Scholarships are open to high school graduates who have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Continued scholarship during duration of technical or undergraduate college education, contingent on maintaining a full-time student status as well as a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Students receiving the scholarship who withdraw from their school for any reason must notify the Foundation within 20 days and return **[the scholarship funds] [any unused funds]** within 90 days.
- Family members of Foundation officers and directors are not eligible for this scholarship award.

Benefits:

- Scholarships are \$2,000 each semester (fall and spring).
- Contingent scholarship continued based on average duration of intended school and field of study.
- Mentorship Opportunities: we will give you a chance to interact with experts in your field, make connections and set you up for career success.
- Academic Benefits: we will walk with you to help you achieve your academic goals and get your dream job.
- Professional Benefits: our scholarship program will help you gain internships, develop your resume and find job placement after leaving college.
- Networking Opportunities: once you are enrolled in our program, you become part of the family, and you can always reach back to help students following your footsteps in the foundation.
